As you read this remember that we, in the Christian Church, continue to celebrate the Season of Epiphany. For many churches, Epiphany is the climax of the Advent/Christmas season. It includes four to nine Sundays depending on the date of Easter. This year we will observe Easter on Sunday, April 16<sup>th</sup>.



The term Epiphany means "to show" or "to make known" or even "to reveal." In Western churches, it remembers the coming of the Wise Men bringing gifts to visit the Christ Child. In so doing they "revealed" Jesus to the world as Lord and King. For many Protestant church traditions, the Season of Epiphany extends from January 6<sup>th</sup> until Ash Wednesday which begins the Season of Lent leading to Easter.

The traditional symbols of Epiphany are usually associated with the Magi, including three crowns or a single crown, three gifts, a five-point star, or a combination of star and crown. A more modern symbol for Epiphany is a globe or an image of the world. Throughout this season, we echo the prayer of the prophet Isaiah who prayed, "*Arise shine; for your Light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you.*" (60:1) May God's Light shine upon you and bless you during this wonderful season.
