You can write a check to SDUMC and write "kits for conference" in memo line.

These are the items that go in the health kit:

1 hand towel

- o 15 x 25 inches to 17 x 27 inches
- o Kitchen, cleaning, and microfiber towels not acceptable

• 1 washcloth

• 1 comb

- o Comb needs to be sturdy and longer than 6 inches long
- o No pocket combs or picks please
- o Rattail combs and combs without handles are acceptable with a minimum of 6 inches of teeth

• 1 metal nail file or nail clippers

- o No emery boards, please

• 1 bath-size soap

- o 3 oz. and larger sizes only
- o No Ivory or Jergens soap due to moisture content
- o Do not remove from original packaging

• 1 toothbrush

- o Adult size only
- o Do not remove from original packaging

• 6 adhesive bandages

- o ¾ inch to 1 inch-size
- o Common household Band-Aids
